

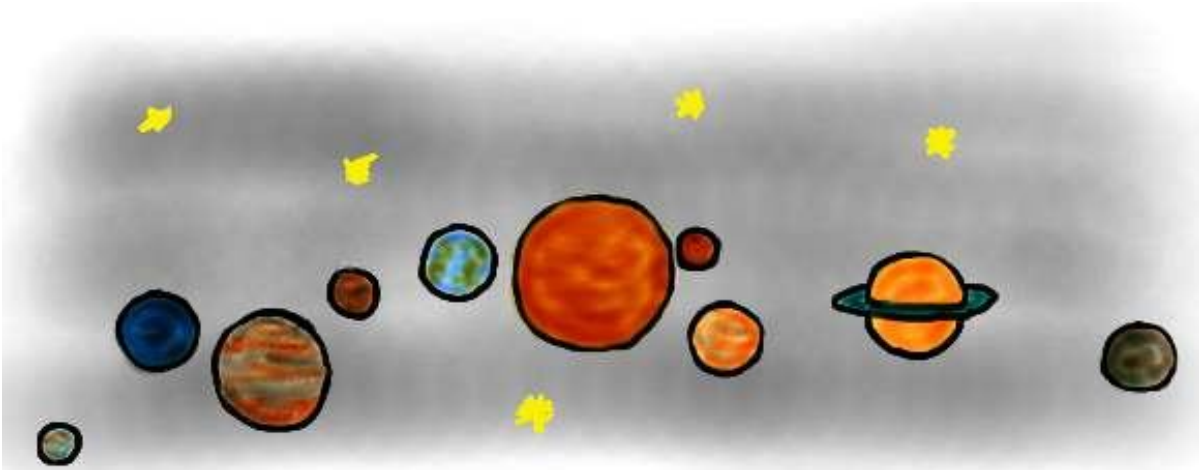
The Sun

Short vowel u (as in run)



The sun is a big star. The Earth **orbits** the sun every 365 days. The sun gives Earth heat and light every day.

When we are close to the sun, it is hot. This is called summer. When we are far from the sun, it is cold. That is called winter. We must have the sun for heat and light.
