

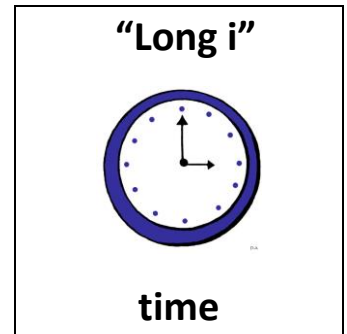
# The Park
